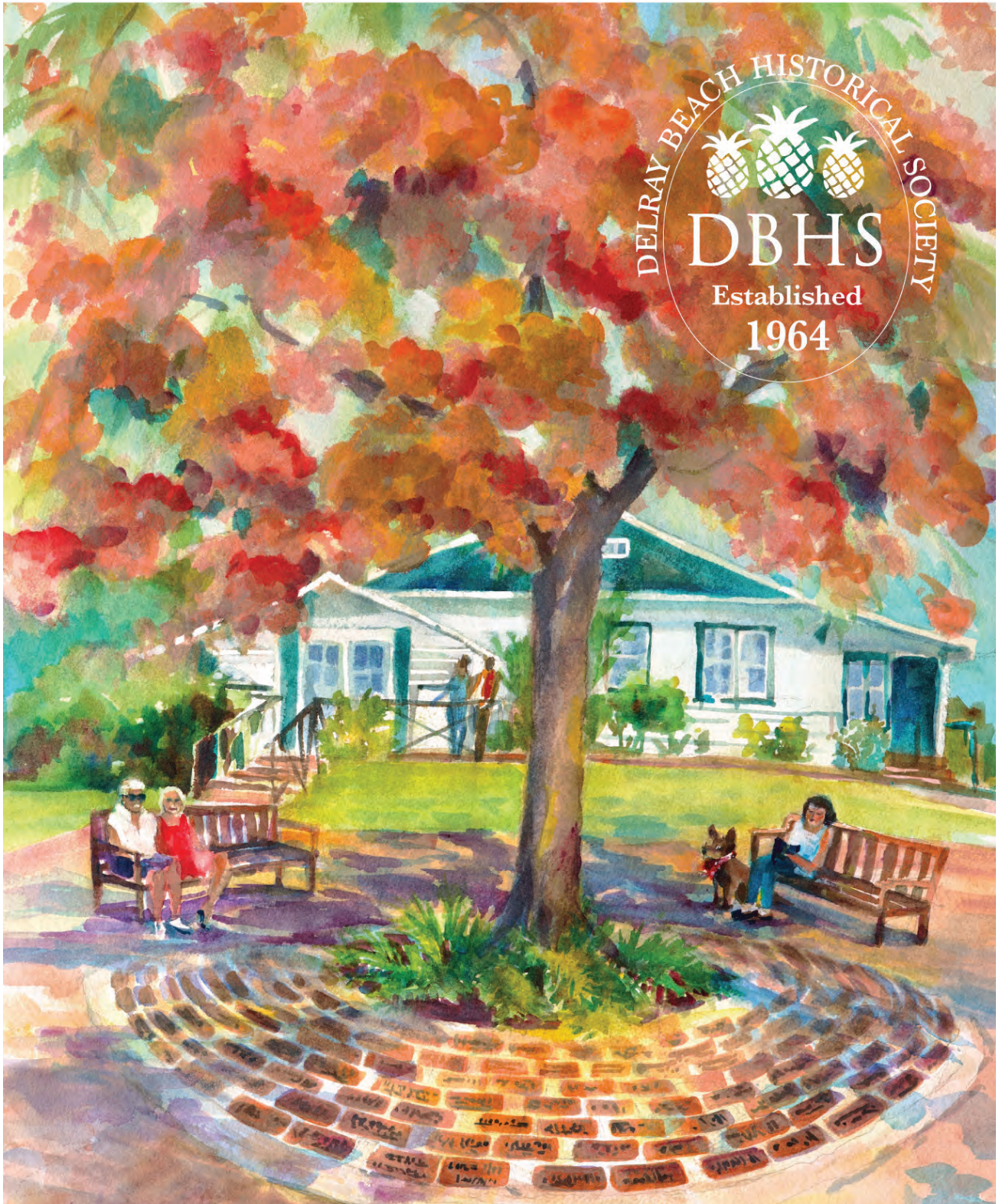
The Father of Delray Architecture, Sam Ogren, Sr. designed the above Adams Chevrolet building in 1949, located at SE 6th Avenue and SE 3rd Street in Delray Beach. It was constructed in 1950 in the MiMo style of Subtropical Modernism, an adaption of the International Style to the local South Florida climate.

In 2014 local developer, Rick Caster restored the boarded-up building and opened a modern showroom and office building. The renovated 7,000 square foot building received an award from the Florida Trust for Historic Preservation and was acknowledged for adaptive reuse. It is also listed on the Local Register of Historic Places. Visit "100 Years of Sam Ogren" Exhibit at Azure through May!

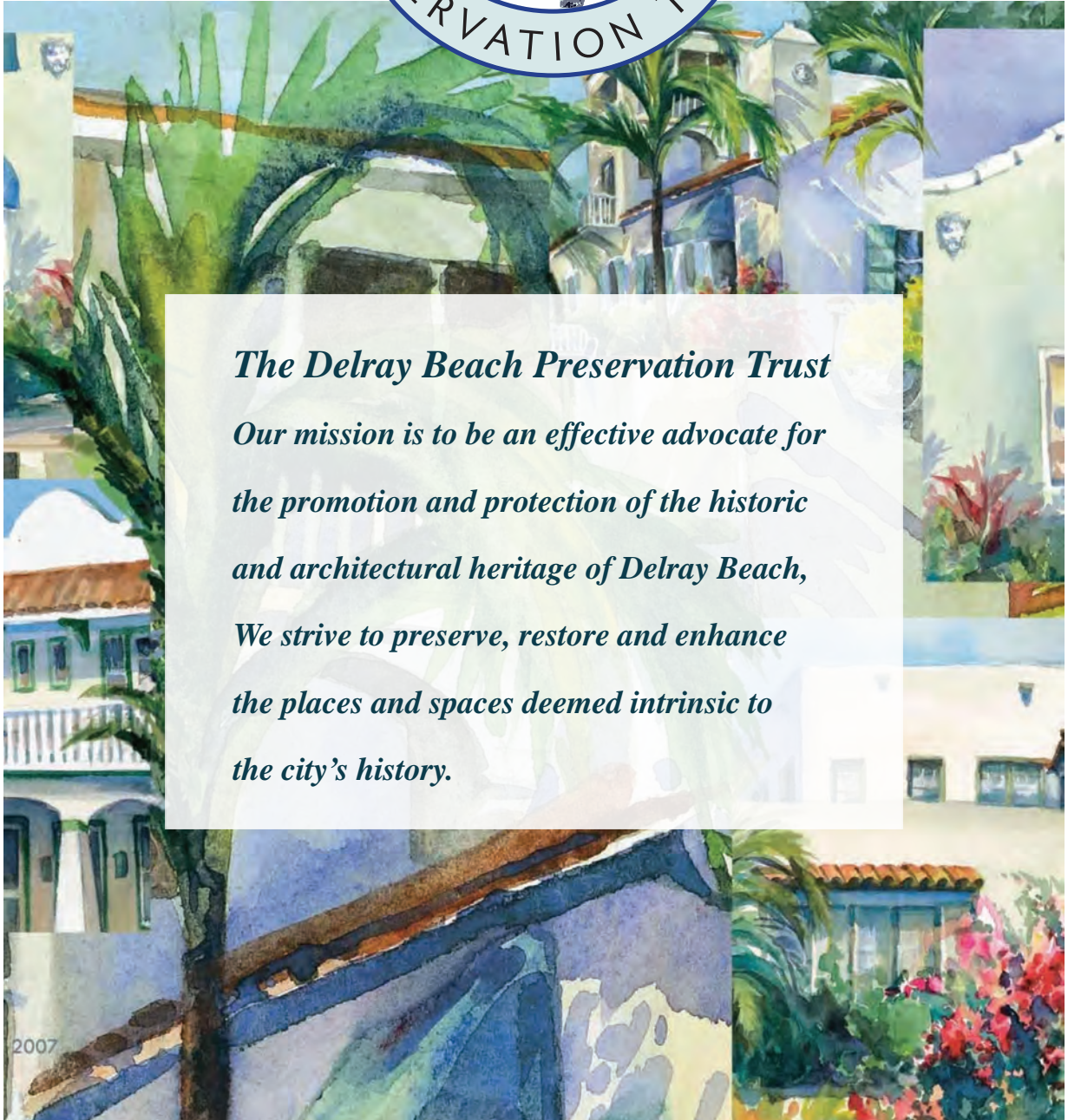

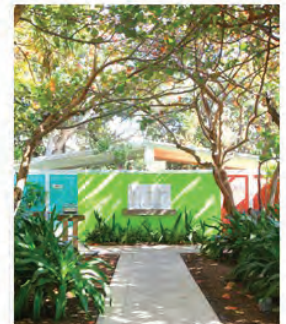
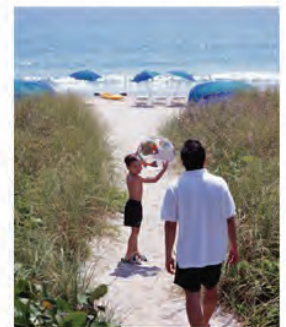
